Arcadia Lodge has been hosting guests for nearly 100 years and reflects the same character and charm it had when it was built over 120 years ago.

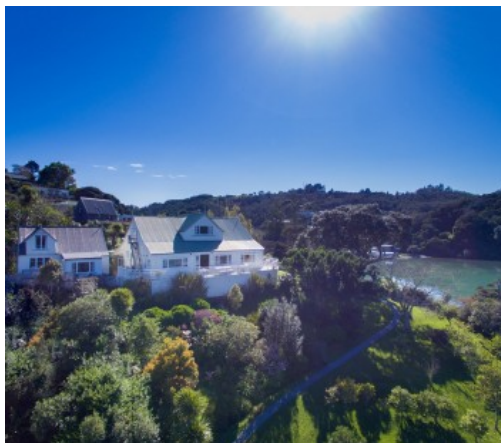

The Downstairs

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The three downstairs luxury rooms have private decks, en-suite bathrooms and stunning water views. Some guests are drawn to the space and separate living spaces within the Te Punga suite, while others prefer the beachy feel of the Tautoru suite. For families or close friends the Matariki suite is an ideal choice—two bedrooms can sleep up to four guests.

The Upstairs

The two upstairs guest rooms are slightly smaller but with a lovely and cozy feel. The Takurua room is light and simple with a fantastic bay view—perfect for the busy traveller. The Ranginui room is without a view of the bay but is instead awash with afternoon and evening sun—one of the best spots in the house to relax at the end of the day.

The Cottage

The 2 bedroom semi self-contained Arcadia cottage is a delightful residence for up to four guests. A full kitchen with a gas stovetop, dining area and two bedrooms are positioned on the ground floor, and a white timber staircase leads up to the mezzanine sitting room which is bathed in natural light. Sit at the beautiful bay window looking out to the yacht-strewn water below, or curl up in one of the luxurious leather recliners with a glass of wine and a good book.
